Notices of Availability of Uncompensated Services

Black River Memorial Hospital, Inc. gives a reasonable amount of its services, without charge to eligible persons who cannot afford to pay for care.

To be eligible to receive uncompensated or discounted care, your family income* must be at or below the following levels:

*Income

1. Refers to total cash receipts before taxes from all sources. These include money wages and salaries before any deductions. They include receipts from self-employment or from your own farm or business after deductions for business or farm expenses. They include regular payments from public assistance, social security, unemployment's and workmen's compensation, strike benefits from union funds, veterans benefits, training stipends, alimony, child support and military family allotments or other regular support from an absent family member or someone not living in the household; government employee pensions, private pensions and regular insurance or annuity payments; and income from dividends, interest, rents, royalties or income from estates and trusts.
2. Black River Memorial Hospital requires that an applicant apply for all benefits that are available to them in their area of residency.
3. Black River Memorial Hospital requires that application be returned within 10 business days of receiving application.

If you think you may be eligible for uncompensated services, you may request them from the Patient Financial Counselors. Black River Memorial Hospital, Inc., will make a written conditional or final determination of your eligibility for uncompensated or discounted services.
